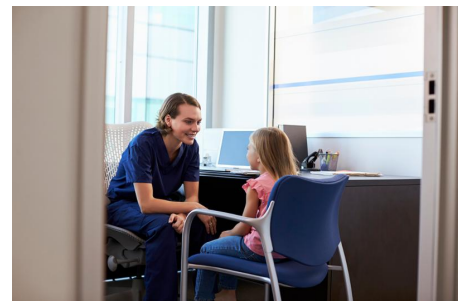

SEPTEMBER IS SUICIDE PREVENTION MONTH



September is National Suicide Prevention Month and an important time to be aware of warning signs and resources available when youth are facing crisis.

Since 2014, Edgewood's **Crisis Stabilization Unit (CSU)** has helped over 1,600 youth ages 5 to 17 facing crisis. According to a report from the San Francisco Department of Public Health, the CSU treated 132 youth considered to be at risk of suicide.

Together, we can raise awareness of this critical issue and ensure that those struggling get the support they need. The CSU is there

Edgewood's Drop-in Center South in Redwood City is marking its second year anniversary of serving Transitional Age Youth ages 18-25 in the southern part of San Mateo County.

Edgewood operates **two Drop-in Centers** located in San Bruno and Redwood City. Both provide a variety of services to young adults in the communities. Peer Partners lead activities that build interpersonal and social skills to help youth transition successfully into adulthood.

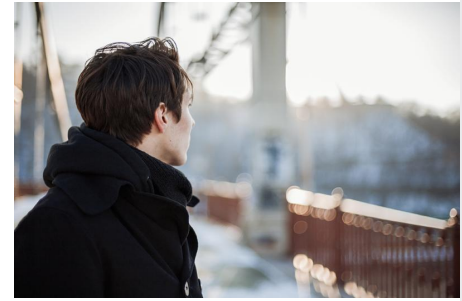
