CAMPUS SERVICES

Crisis Stabilization Unit:

Open 24/7 for insurance-based referrals. Provides assessment, triage, and stabilization services to youth, ages 5 - 17, experiencing acute psychiatric crisis. Call 415-682-3278 for additional information.

Residentially-Based Services:

We are currently serving youth in our Hospital Diversion and Short-Term Residential Therapeutic Programs. We continue to review new referrals while monitoring risk levels. We have suspended our IOP/PHP programs.

Edgewood Community School:

Program services have been modified to provide "virtual learning" opportunities and telehealth therapy sessions.

BAYVIEW / EAST BAY SERVICES

WRAP, Outpatient & Therapeutic Behavioral Services:

Modified services. Utilizing telehealth alternatives and in-person meetings as clinically indicated. All open for intakes.

School-Based Services & Early Childhood Mental Health Consulting:

Direct care services are suspended due to school closures. Telehealth alternatives being offered.

Family Resource Center & Kinship:

In-person meetings suspended. Utilizing telehealth alternatives.

Food Bank:

Services continue with new safety procedures in place.

SAN MATEO SERVICES

After School Intensive Services and Drop-in Center Services:

Programming has been suspended.

TAY Full Service Partnership, Youth Full Service Partnership, and Kinship Services:

In-person meetings suspended. Utilizing telehealth alternatives.

Support Groups and Family Conferencing:

In-person meetings suspended. Utilizing telehealth alternatives.

Crisis Response Team:

Continues to support families in the evenings and weekends.
